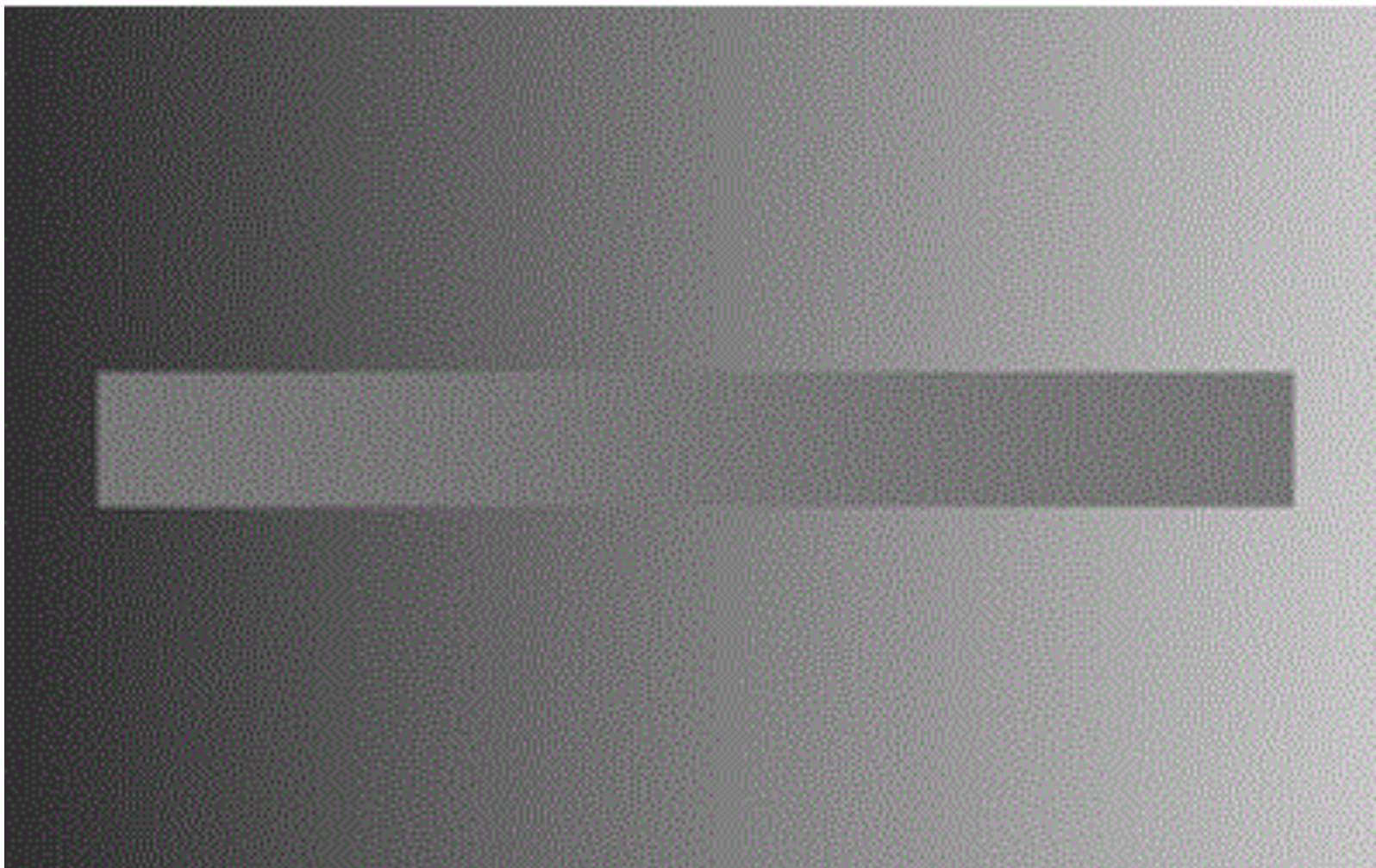


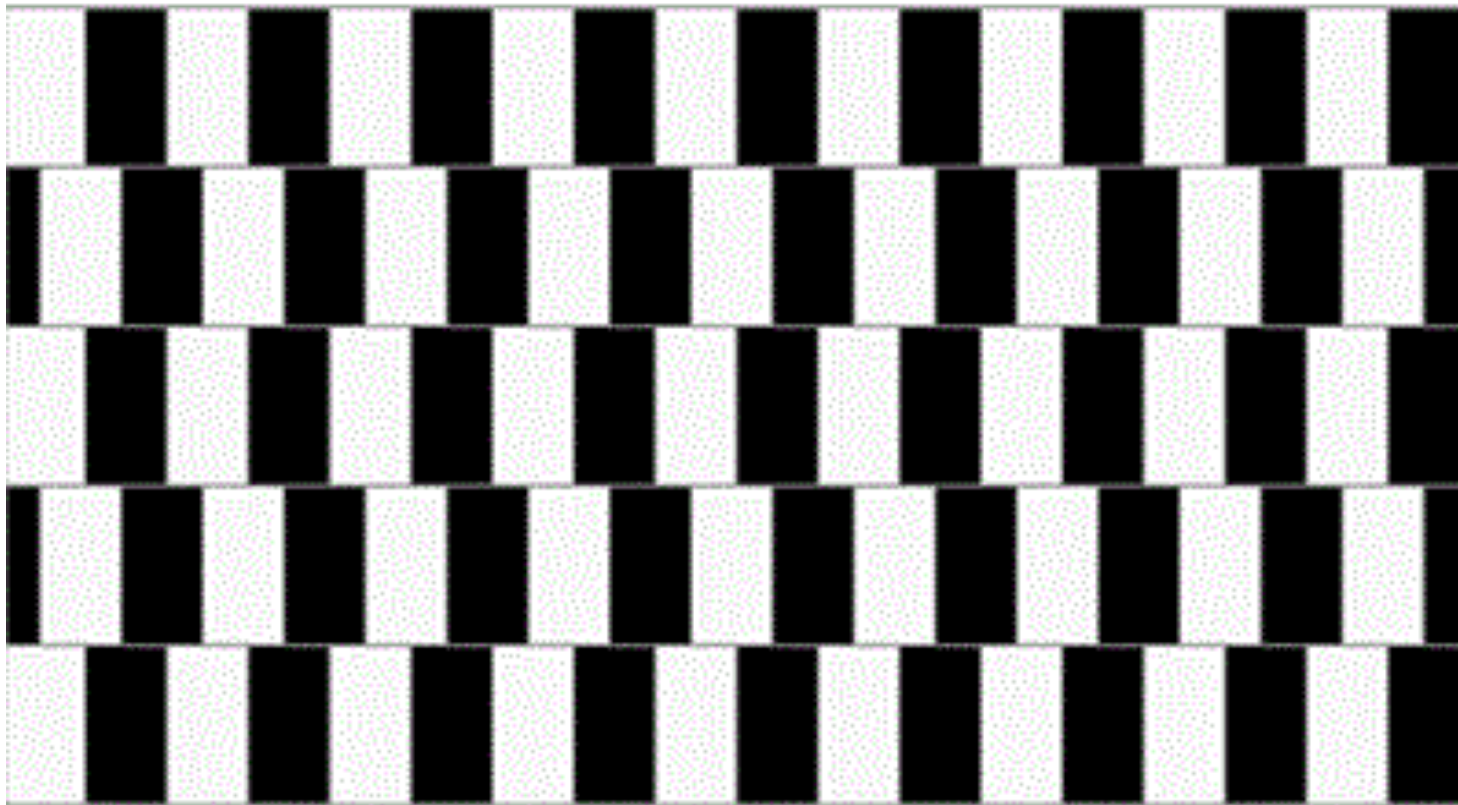
How many legs has the elephant got?



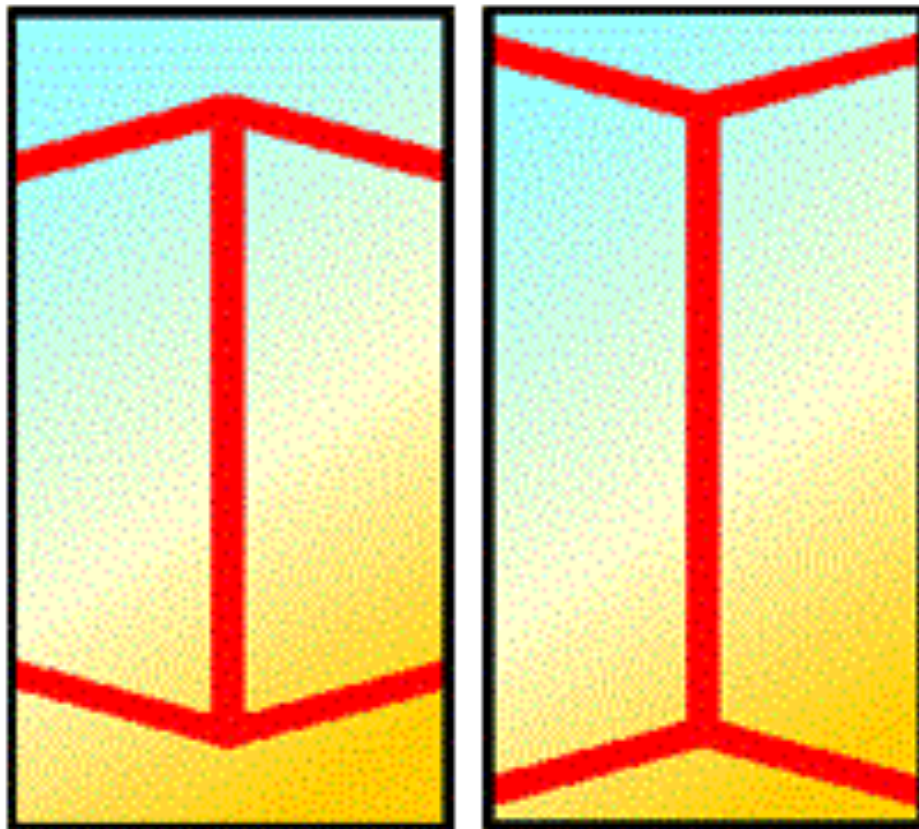
How many animals can you see?

Which of the vertical lines is longer?

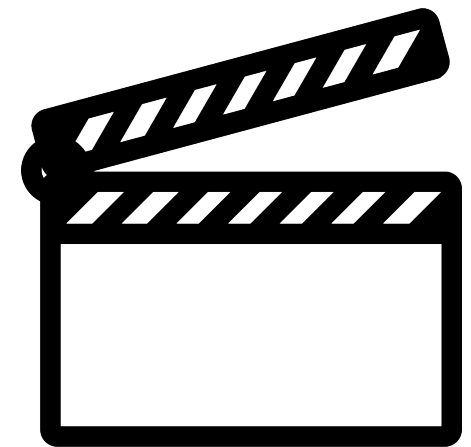




This is LOU.
