

Listening to God's world

This activity encourages nursery aged children to listen to the world around them, all the sounds that they can hear both inside and outside the home.

As the restrictions on our daily lives begin to relax, it is now possible to get outside more - but this activity can also be done near an open window.



A story on how the world began

Tell your child that the Bible has a story in it about how God created the world in seven days. He did one job every day until the Earth was made and then on Sunday he had a long sleep.

On the next page you will find a picture showing what God made on each day.

Days of Creation

GENESIS 1



You might like to help your child to make pictures of the different days, using the lollipop idea below.



Talk to your child about how lovely the world is - the flowers in your garden, the clouds in the sky, etc.



Explain that the world is also full of lovely sounds and that you are going to go on a sound walk together.

Take a piece of paper with you, encourage your child to listen carefully and tell you what they can hear. You then both draw a picture of what you can hear (birds/cars/the wind).
